Abstract

According to Hindu mythology, it is the emblem of Varuna, also considered an embodiment of kingship. garbhagriha. is the sanctum sanctorum, the innermost sanctum of a Hindu temple where resides the idol of the primary deity of the temple. hinduism. a major religious and cultural tradition of South Asia, developed from Vedic religion. horizontal axis. A healthy church is not simply a church wrapped up in continual introspection and self-purification. It is a church wholly in love with Christ and fully committed to His Great Commission (Matthew 28:19–20). It isn't a church where members are consumed with their own feelings and preferences, but a church where members are growing individually and as a church family. What is a healthy church? From the earliest days of the local church, there have been opportunities to serve others. (See Acts 6.) Sometimes people new to a church look at all that is already taking place and think that they are not needed. The truth is that every church has needs and that when God adds someone to the church, He is fitting them into a body that He knows needs them.
