Thus, "Daoism" encompasses thought and practice that sometimes are viewed as "philosophical," as "religious," or as a combination of both. While modern scholars, especially those in the West, have been preoccupied with classifying Daoist material as either "philosophical" or "religious," historically Daoists themselves have been uninterested in such categories and dichotomies.
