Once established, tree kale can grow six to eight feet tall and four to six feet wide, producing a huge amount of leaves. Provide support for the plants as they grow by inserting a six foot tall wooden stake or grow it against a trellis. In colder climates, you can plant tree kale in big pots and bring it indoors for the winter. Give the patch time to establish and spread, so hold off harvesting homegrown ramps for at least three to four years, especially if your plants were grown from seed.
